The workshop "E-Taxation: State & Perspectives" will be held on February 22, 2007 within the 10th International Symposium on Legal Informatics (February 22-24, 2006) at the University of Salzburg, Austria.

At the workshop, current questions of IT-based tax administration will be discussed. We aim to provide a broad approach to the subject, covering especially the following topics:

- The value chain of the taxation process
- The cross-organisational orchestration of electronic taxation processes and its (organisational, semantic, technical) interoperability aspects
- The involvement of the e-taxation stakeholders (citizens, businesses, proxies, administration) in the design process
- The interdependency of e-taxation and socio-cultural aspects, political issues, legal frameworks as well as organisational and procedural preconditions regarding the above mentioned stakeholders
- The process-oriented use of knowledge management techniques for a better accomplishment of taxation, with regard to tax payers, their professional proxies and the tax administration
- Work environment changes triggered by the implementation of e-taxation systems and the repositioning of the users regarding all stakeholders
- Data security and privacy requirements, their further development in the context of e-taxation, and the compliance with the increased requirements in this field
- The increased use of information technology and its effect on the other aspects of e-taxation
- Proposals for a Roadmap from One-Stop Government to No-Stop Government in the field of Taxation
- New e-taxation aspects and possibilities due to mobile technologies

- The integration of e-payment and digital signatures in the e-taxation process
- IT-support for special aspects of e-taxation, like tax auditing, special administrative cooperation in the field of e-taxation etc.
- Experiences, good practices and procedures of national, regional and municipal tax administrations

Your contribution should deal with above mentioned topics, but does not have to be limited to them. We are open to related issues and your special approach to these issues. We are happy to accept both, contributions from the research sector (concepts, frameworks, etc.) and the presentation of practical experiences with tools and procedures and examples for good practice and "lessons learned" in e-taxation practice.

The acceptance of papers will depend on their relevance, level of innovation and clarity of argumentation/ presentation.

Language:

Though the conference language is German, contributions in English are very welcome.

Submission of Contributions:

Publication of Papers:

The fully elaborated papers will be published in the proceedings of the 10th International Symposium on Legal Informatics. Alternatively publication in the planned book "E-Taxation: Volume 2" is possible. More details will be given in the course of the symposium.
